

VOTING GUIDELINES FOR THE ELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Vote by mail deadline for 2022 is September 28

The 2022 LITC Fall General Meeting will be held on October 1st. Thirty days prior to the meeting the office will mail out ballots and an information packet to all members in good standing*

The packet will contain:

- Information on candidates seeking election to the Board
- The proposed annual budget for 2023
- The Directed Proxy ballot for your vote

NOTE: This information packet can also be supplied to you by email if you provide the Office Administrator with a written and signed request.

If you are voting by mailing, your **ballot must be received back in the office by Wednesday, September 28.**

You can also vote at the General Meeting, on October 1st. Directed Proxy ballots will be available at the meeting.

*How do we determine Members in Good Standing? Thirty days before the date of the General Meeting all members who have paid their annual dues, who have no outstanding fines or special assessments, and who are otherwise in compliance with all Covenants, By-Laws and Rules, will be declared Members in Good Standing. This year that means the date of record will be September 1.
